2025-09 Road Department Clothing Allowance

Clothing allowance will be paid as follows per IRS regulations that make clothing allowance a taxable item: Full-time \$300 per year
Uniforms will be provided for full time employees by Cintas. Mesler moved, Stratton seconded.

2025-10 Road Department Hours

Normal working hours are 7:00am – 3:30pm, with a 30 minute unpaid lunch break, 40 hours per week, Monday thru Friday. Trustees to assist with scheduling if they feel the need arises. Mesler moved, Stratton seconded. Voting YES – Mesler, Bricker, Stratton. Motion carried.

2025-11 Mileage

Mileage will be paid at \$.70/mile, payment of necessary expense for parking and lodging to Trustees, Fiscal Officer, and township employees for business outside the township, and meals, including tips, up to a maximum of \$50.00/day.
